The Dutchess County PHA is pleased to once again offer the High Score Program. This Program is a fun and competitive way for riders to earn points throughout the season towards year end awards as well as the opportunity to qualify for a National Finals. The National PHA Finals will be held October 28-30, 2022 at Gardnertown Farms In Newburgh, New York. The top 5 riders/horses from each division will qualify for the National PHA Finals. Riders must compete in a minimum of 2 DCPHA shows to be eligible for the Finals.

Divisions offered:

*Lead Line: Riders 8 and under, to show at Walk and Trot with a handler

Walk Trot (Equation or Pleasure): Open to all ages

*Academy Equitation: Junior and Adult Amateur riders not ready for Short Stirrup, Jumps 18"

Short Stirrup: Riders 14 and under, Jumps 18"

Long Stirrup: Amateur Riders 15 and over, Jumps 18"

Pre-Children's Equitation: Riders 17 and under, jumps 2'

Pre-Adult Equitation: Amateur riders 18 and over, Jumps 2'

Beginner Hunter: Open to all ages, Horses and ponies judged together, Jumps 2'

Modified Children's Equitation: Riders 17 and under, Jumps 2'6"

Modified Adult Equitation: Amateur Riders 18 and over, Jumps 2'6"

Low Hunters: Open to all rider and all horses/ponies, Jumps 2'6"

Low Child Hunters: Riders 17 and under, Open all horses/ponies, Jumps 2'6"

Low Adult Hunters: Amateur Riders 18 and over, Open to all horses/ponies, Jumps 2'6"

Children's Medal: Riders 17 and under, Jumps 3'

Adult Medal: Amateur riders 18 and over, Jumps 3'

High Hunters: Open to all rider and all horses/ponies, Jumps 3'

*2' Jumpers: Open to all riders/horses/ponies

2'6" Jumpers: Open to all riders/horses/ponies

*3' Jumpers: Open to all riders/horses/ponies

Low Child/Adult Jumpers: Open to Junior and Adult Amateur Riders, Fences 3' to 3'3

*3'6" Jumpers: Open to all riders/horses/ponies

*High Child/Adult Jumpers: Open to Junior and Adult Amateur Riders, Fences 3'6"

*4' Open Jumpers: Open to All horses/ponies

Divisions marked with asterisk are not offered at National PHA Finals
